




# BNL Injuries FY13

# Incremental Injury Rates are Up

- BNL: Most events are “head in the game” injuries
  - Slips, trips and falls, 47%
  - Lacerations, 27%
- C-AD: 03/31/2014 An employee lacerated his fingers against equipment in the Machine Shop. He was sent to a local ER for sutures. Sharp Edge, No Days Lost and No Restricted Work
- C-AD: 02/19/2014 An employee slipped and fell on a water and ice covered surface. At the OMC, first aid was given. The worker was sent home and has now lost time from work. Slip/Trip, 51 Lost Days
- C-AD: 12/11/2013 An employee was performing leak checks when he injured his foot. He received first aid at the OMC. Later went to an orthopedist and returned to work on restrictions. Overexertion, 28 Restricted Work Days
